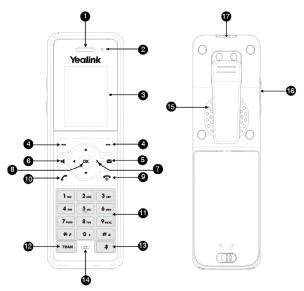

Get to Know Your Yealink Cordless Phone



No.	Item	Description	
1	Receiver	Receives audio in receiver mode.	
2	Power LED Indicator	Indicates call status, message status, and charging status.	
3	Phone Screen	Shows information.	
4	Soft Keys	Access the function directly. It depends on the operating situation.	
5	Message Key	Accesses the voice mail or missed call.	
6	Speakerphone Key	Switches among the receiver, headset, and handsfree modes. Answers an incoming call. Places a call in handsfree mode.	
7	Navigation Keys	Scroll through information or options on the screen.	
8	OK Key	Confirms actions or enters the main menu.	
9	On-hook Key/Power Key	Press briefly to return to the previous screen. Long press to return to the idle screen. Press to turn the handset on. Long press on the idle screen to turn the handset off. Cancels actions or ends a call. Rejects an incoming call.	
10	Off-hook Key	Answers an incoming call. Enters the redial calls list. Places a call in receiver or headset mode	
11	Keypad	Provides digits, letters, and special characters.	
12	TRAN Key	Transfers a call to another party.	
13	Mute Key	Toggles mute feature on or off.	
14	Microphone	Picks up audio.	
15	Speaker	Outputs audio in handsfree mode.	
16	Volume Key +/-	Adjusts volume.	
17	Emergency Alarm Button	Long press 2 seconds to set off the emergency alarm.	

Calling Options

Dial Phone Numbers or Extensions

Enter the desired number when the handset is idle.

- Local and Long distance dial the 10-digit phone number (area code + local number)
- International dial 011 + country code + city code + number
- Internal extension dial the extension

Answer Calls

- To answer a call, press the *Accept* soft key or press
- Other options are to press Speakerphone button , or press (ox)
- To answer a new call while on an active call, press down arrow ▼ to navigate to new call and then press the Accept soft key (the current call will be held)

Hold Calls

- Place a call on hold by pressing the Options soft key, and then select Hold. The held party will hear music/ message while holding
- To resume a held call, press the **Resume** soft key

Transfer Calls

Transfer Call to an Extension or Other Number

- During a live call, press Options, then Transfer and dial the ext/number
- 2. When you hear the ring back sound, or after you have talked with the other party, press *Transfer* and hang up



If you press *Transfer* or hang up directly after hearing the ring back sound, the call will automatically transfer without having to announce the caller.

Transfer Call Directly to Voicemail

- During a live call, press *Options*, then *Transfer* and dial *55 followed by the ext/number
- 2. Press Transfer again

Conference Calling

To Conduct a Conference Call

- Call the first party. After party answers, press Options, then Conference
- Dial the extension or phone for the second party and press *Conf*. When party answers, press *Conf* again; all three parties are joined together in conference

Muting a Call

Do Not Disturb

To enable do not disturb, press . Select Call Features
 Do Not Disturb > Press right arrow to toggle Enabled
 Save.

The icon on the status bar indicates that DND mode is activated and any incoming calls will be directed to voicemail

Changing Volume

- To change call volume, press

 or

 during a call.
- To change the ringer volume, press

 or

 when the phone is idle or ringing

Directory

To access the directory, press (as) and then navigate to the directory icon and press (as) again. Select Network Directory > All Contacts. Navigate to and highlight the desired contact. Press the dial button and (as) to call the highlighted contact

Group Call Park

 While on an active call, press Options and then navigate down ▼ to Group Call Park. Press (x) . Listen to the message which identifies the extension the call is parked on

Unpark

 To unpark a call, dial *88 followed by the park extension and then press the Call button or #
